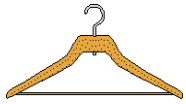




What do I bring for admission?



Clothing & Personal Belongings

We suggest that you bring the following items for your child upon admission:

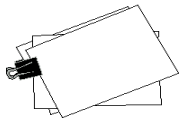
Residential Treatment

- 7 sets of clothes, underwear, socks
- 2 pairs of shoes
- Toiletries & hygiene supplies
- Pajamas & slippers or socks
- Swimsuit or Jacket (seasonal)

Acute Care

- 5 sets of clothes, underwear, socks
- 1 pair of shoes, no laces
- Toiletries & hygiene supplies
- Pajamas & slippers or socks
- Jacket (seasonal)

Additionally, please feel free to bring items that may help your child feel more at home, like books, pictures (no glass in frame), posters, and vending machine money. We ask that you please refrain from bringing food and snacks from home. Also, please see your child's cottage program regarding whether or not electronics, stuffed animals, or other items are allowed.

We will need the following Documentation to admit your child to treatment:
